## **K-2 Classroom Updates**

The K-2 detectives are on the case. We have lots of mysteries and missions to solve. We even have detective lens to help us. Our mission is to really study and look closely at the words and books around us. We look closely at the pictures in our books to help us see more. We look closely at all the parts of a word as we read. We study words to notice patterns like silent e or r-controlled vowels. We study master authors to learn what they do as writers. We study our own writing to find bloopers and mess-ups so we can learn from them. We study alphabet charts to learn more sounds and the letters that go with them. We have lots of investigating to do to help us become the best readers and writers we can be!

## **3-5 Classroom Updates**

Third and fourth graders are beginning to work with multiplication in math. Memorizing multiplication tables will be coming soon. Grades 3-4 have also started a new novel, The Mouse and the Motorcycle. We have done some bigger projects this week. Come see our "Northeast" posters and our Stone Fox mobiles. Grade 5 will begin a new novel next week. We are all working on our cursive writing. It's easy to improve when we do just a letter or two at a time.

## **6-8 Classroom Updates**

Our 8th graders enjoyed a day off of school to go and visit Minnesota Valley Lutheran High School this past Monday. They got to experience what a day is like in the life of a high schooler. In writing class we have been working on putting together step-by-step "How-To" paragraphs in which we are teaching our classmates how to do various tasks that we are skilled at. We also recently finished writing letters to our Minnesota State Representative and State Senator about the topic of abortion. We used Bible passages to remind our representatives about the Biblical truth that God values all human life - even the lives of the unborn. God tells us in His word that it is God who forms us even before we are born and that we were valuable beings to God even before God even created us! For this reason, we want to work to help defend the lives of all people. Our letters were shared online by the WELS News Facebook page followed by over 13,000 people! Hundreds of people have read and "liked" our letters! We look forward to hearing back from our representatives and pray that our letters and God's Word make an impact on those who read our letters.
