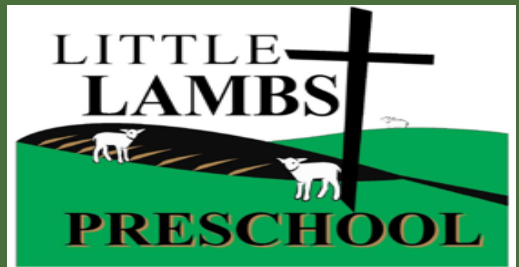

K-2 Classroom Updates

We loved spending time outside for the first half of the week enjoying God's beautiful creation and the warm weather before the cold and windy weather arrived.
